The venue will be the Universidad Pontificia Comillas in Madrid Spain on May 31-June 2, 2017.

This colloquium intends to bring together wind-farm researchers from different disciplines to present their work on planning, operation, and markets for large wind farms. This may include studies on control and integration in the electricity grid, market behavior and design, economics of investment, optimal farm configuration, etc. Cross-disciplinary works on these topics are also highly welcome. There will be small sessions with significant opportunities for interaction and in-depth exploration of these topics. (Please note that an additional Windfarms2017 meeting will take place later this summer as part of the WESC conference at DTU in the form of a mini-symposium.)

Abstracts should be submitted by March 1, 2017, and should be 2-3 pages in IEEE format. Notification of acceptance will be provided by April 1, 2017. There is no paper requirement.
